

## Open-Rank, Tenure-Track Faculty Position in Health Care Organization and Management

Successful applicants will demonstrate the ability to conduct high quality research in health care organization and management, secure extramural funding, teach relevant courses, and advise students from across our degree programs. Candidates must have completed all the requirements for a doctoral degree at the time of appointment. Expertise in qualitative and quantitative research methods and implementation science are preferred.

The faculty and students of the Health Policy and Management Department are multidisciplinary and engage in research that encompasses a wide array of topics including implementation science, cancer, dental public health, mental health, children's health, comparative effectiveness, and rural healthcare.
